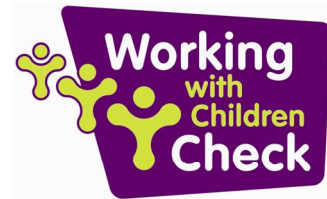

### INFORMATION SESSIONS FOR EMPLOYERS, SELF EMPLOYED, and VOLUNTEER COORDINATORS

Under WA law, many people who carry out 'child-related work', either paid, unpaid or voluntary, must undergo a Working with Children Check.

Counselling and support services, schools, sports and service clubs, child care, entertainment, churches, children's health services, school buses, tutoring and babysitting are some examples of areas where people may come under this legislation.

The Working with Children Screening Unit is offering sessions to provide information on what employers, self employed people and volunteer coordinators need to know to: Comply with the legislation; How to renew a Check; and to answer other questions you may have.
