## Department of Sport and Recreation EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST

### PROFESSIONAL COMBAT SPORTS COMMISSIONERS (3)

The Professional Combat Sports Commission (PCSC), the controlling body for all professional combat sports contests held in Western Australia, is seeking applications from persons wishing to be considered for appointment as Commissioners.

The role of the PCSC is to ensure the health and safety of all combat sports contest participants by overseeing all promotions and providing guidance and leadership to all members of the industry from contestants through to promoters and trainers.

Based at the Department of Sport and Recreation (DSR), the PCSC is supported by DSR and its staff in regards to Executive Services; Administration & Finance Management; Communications & Advocacy; and Learning & Development. This provides the PCSC with a committed base of operations and access to a high level of support and knowledge.

The PCSC has three positions, which will become vacant as of 31 January 2011.

1. One person who has knowledge of the boxing industry;
2. One person who has knowledge of the industry relating to combat sports other than boxing; and
3. One person who represents persons who are or have been registered as contestants in a class relevant to boxing.

It is possible that a fourth position will be created at the same time, dependent on amendments to the *PCS Act 1987* being passed. This role will be specific to someone who has knowledge of the combat sport known as Mixed Martial Arts.

The position of Commissioner is remunerated and will be effective as of 1 February 2010 and will run for a term of either one, two or three years.
